

RODRIGO MORENO SPAIN



Prof. Rodrigo Moreno graduated in Chemistry by Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (1984) where he also obtained the PhD degree (1988). Prof. Moreno became tenured scientist at the Institute of Ceramics & Glass (CSIC, Spain) in 1990, Research Scientist in 1999, and Research Professor in 2004. He was head of the Department of Ceramics at ICV (2006-2008) and is the leader of the Synthesis and Colloidal Processing Group at ICV from 2005.

His main interest lies on the synthesis of ceramic powders, the colloidal stability and rheology of ceramic suspensions, and the manufacture of structural and functional materials by colloidal processing techniques.

He is co-author of more than 240 ISI journal articles, 9 patents, several book chapters, and one book. He has been member of the organization committees of more than 40 national and international conferences and has pronounced more than 50 invited lectures.

Prof. Moreno is member of the Spanish Ceramic Society from 1989, where he was secretary of the Basic Science division (1999-2000) and member of the redaction committee of Bol Soc Esp Ceram Vidr (2000-2004). He has a remarkable implication with the Journal of ECerS, with more than 70 published papers and an active participation as reviewer and editor. He has participated in the edition of 2 special issues of J Eur Ceram Soc and became one of the editors in 2011, with more than 750 articles handled up to now.
