Dr Fabrice ROSSIGNOL (52 years old) obtained his PhD in 1995 from the University of Limoges in the field of ceramic processes and surface treatments. He was a post-doc at the Agency for Industrial Science and Technology in Japan from 1996 to 1998. He then joined the industry as a technical manager for Bosch company from 1999 to 2001. In 2002, he returned to academia as a researcher at the National Center for Scientific Research (CNRS) assigned to the Institute of Research for Ceramics (IRCER) in Limoges, France. He was appointed Director of Research at the CNRS in 2012.

From 2007 to 2017, F. ROSSIGNOL was the head of the Ceramic Processes team at IRCER. Since 2018, he has held the position of Deputy Director of IRCER. His research work covers two main aspects in strong relationship with companies:

- The shaping of nanostructured ceramics (top-down/bottom-up approaches),
- The development of additive manufacturing technologies

He has published 70 papers and 25 patents. He is currently Editor of the Journal of the European Ceramic Society.
